#### What we do

- Multi-agency training among industry, municipal emergency services, law enforcement, provincial and regulatory agencies
- Create a strong expert network in all aspects of response
- Advocate for and work collectively on safety initiatives that enhance regional safety
- Collective voice to communicate Shelter in Place safety and 72-hour preparedness to residents in our region




### **Regional Sign Project**

- 7 digital signs at key locations in four major municipalities
- 3 static "flashing" signs at HWY 15/37/824 intersection










#### Anticipated timeline


