Who we are


Northeast Region Community Awareness Emergency Response (NRCAER) is a mutual aid emergency response association/registered society formed in 1991.

Why Mutual Aid?

- Emergency Management is a TEAM sport
- No single entity owns, or is 'expert' at, everything
- Residents expect Public Safety
- Big incidents impact beyond boundaries
- Good relationships = good response
- Right thing to do. Don't compete on safety.

- Emergency response training
- Promote Shelter in Place safety and 72-hour preparedness to residents in our region

Dynamic and Static Message Signs

- 7 digital + 3 static signs at key locations in four major municipalities
- Equipped with cameras that can be viewed on 511 Alberta
- Commissioned end of 2022
- Increase safety with ability to alert & divert motoring public
- Enhances current notification methods



2024 Survey Results




