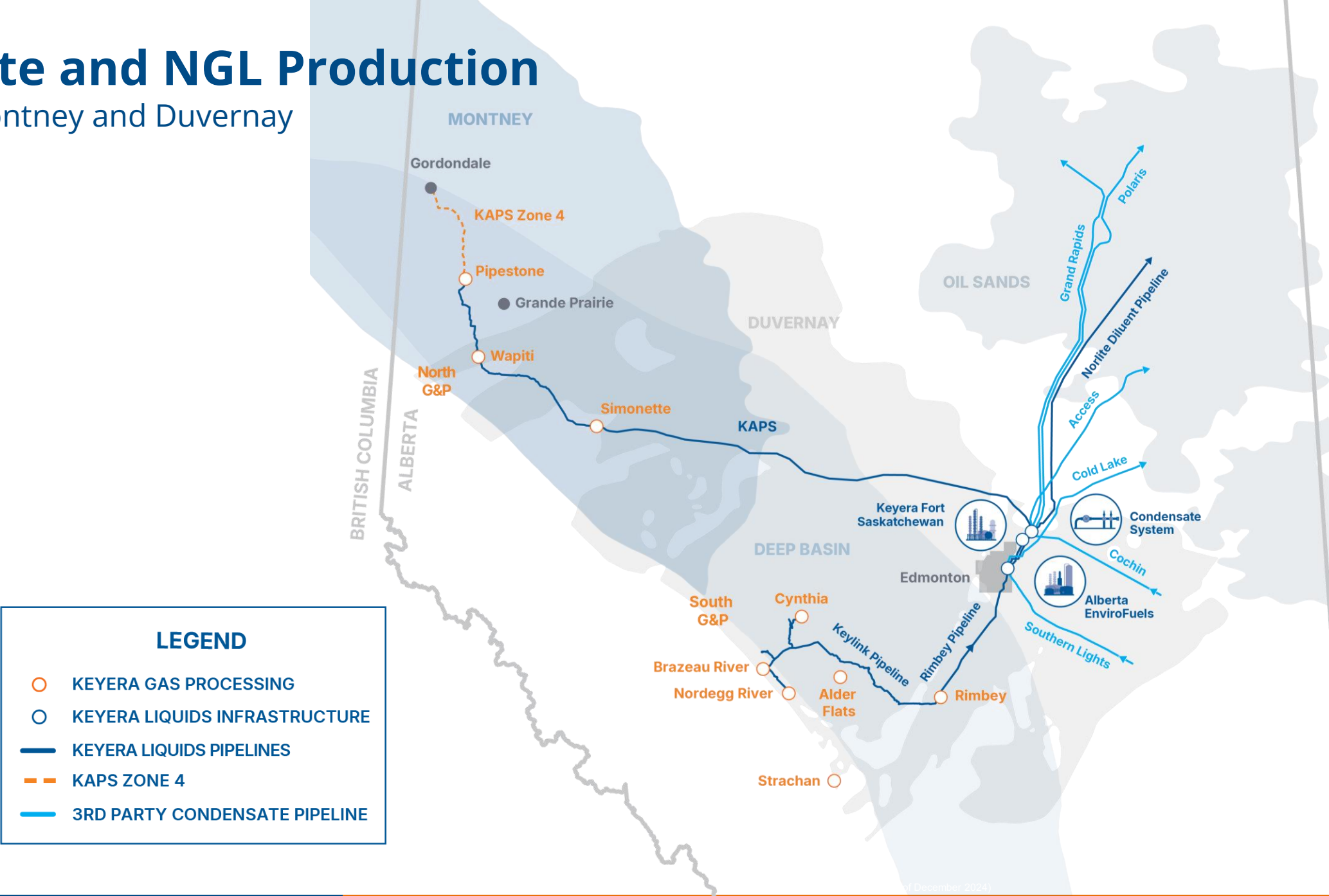

Products produced by Keyera



Propane: A versatile energy source used for heating, cooking, and as a fuel in various applications.



Butane: Utilized in gasoline blending, as a fuel source, and in the production of synthetic rubber.



Ethane: Separated from raw natural gas and used as a feedstock in petrochemical industries for producing plastics and other chemicals.



Condensate: Primarily employed as a diluent to facilitate the transportation of heavy crude oil through pipelines.



Iso-octane: A high-octane component produced at Keyera's Alberta EnviroFuels facility, the largest iso-octane manufacturing plant globally. Iso-octane is used to enhance the quality of gasoline.

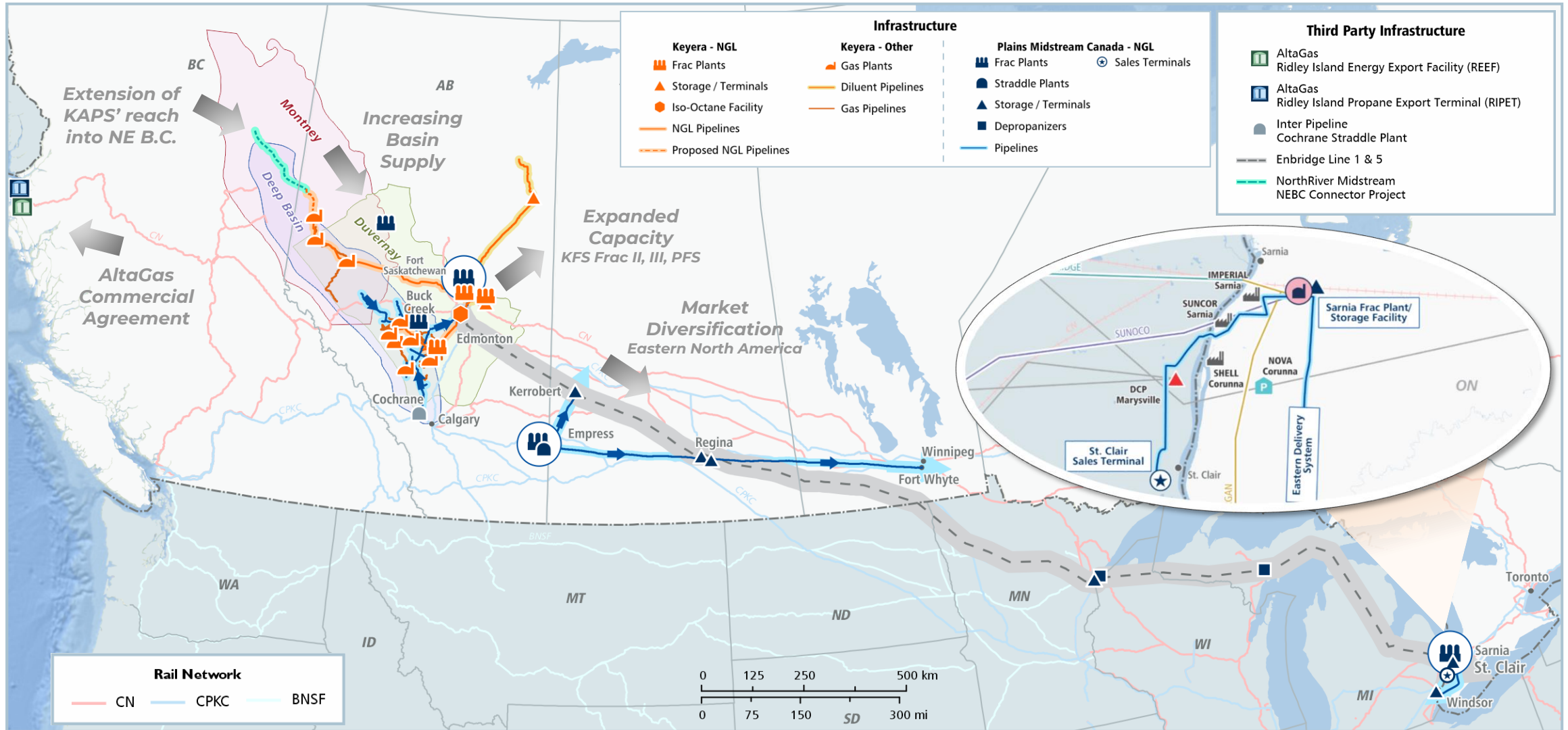

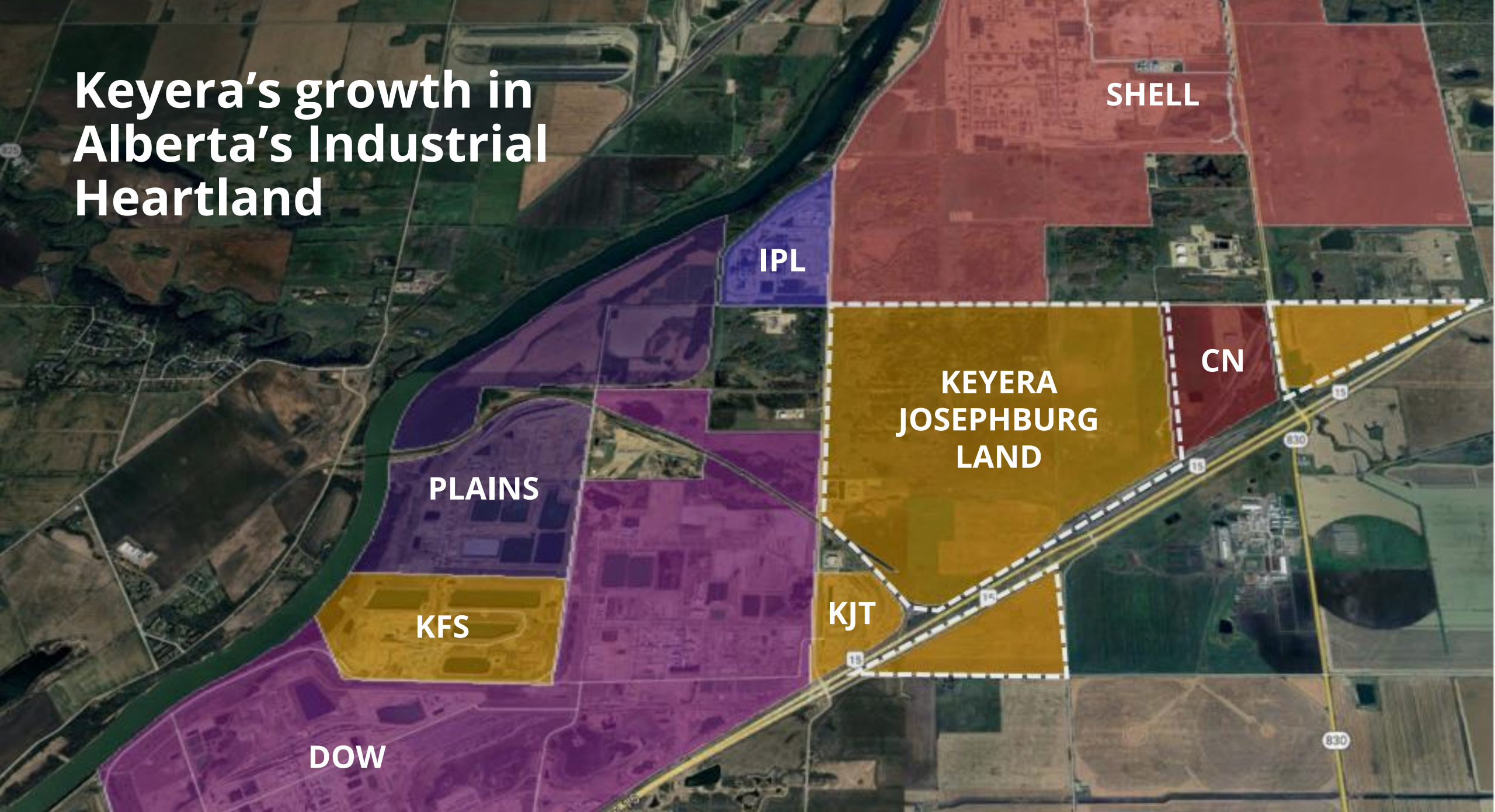
