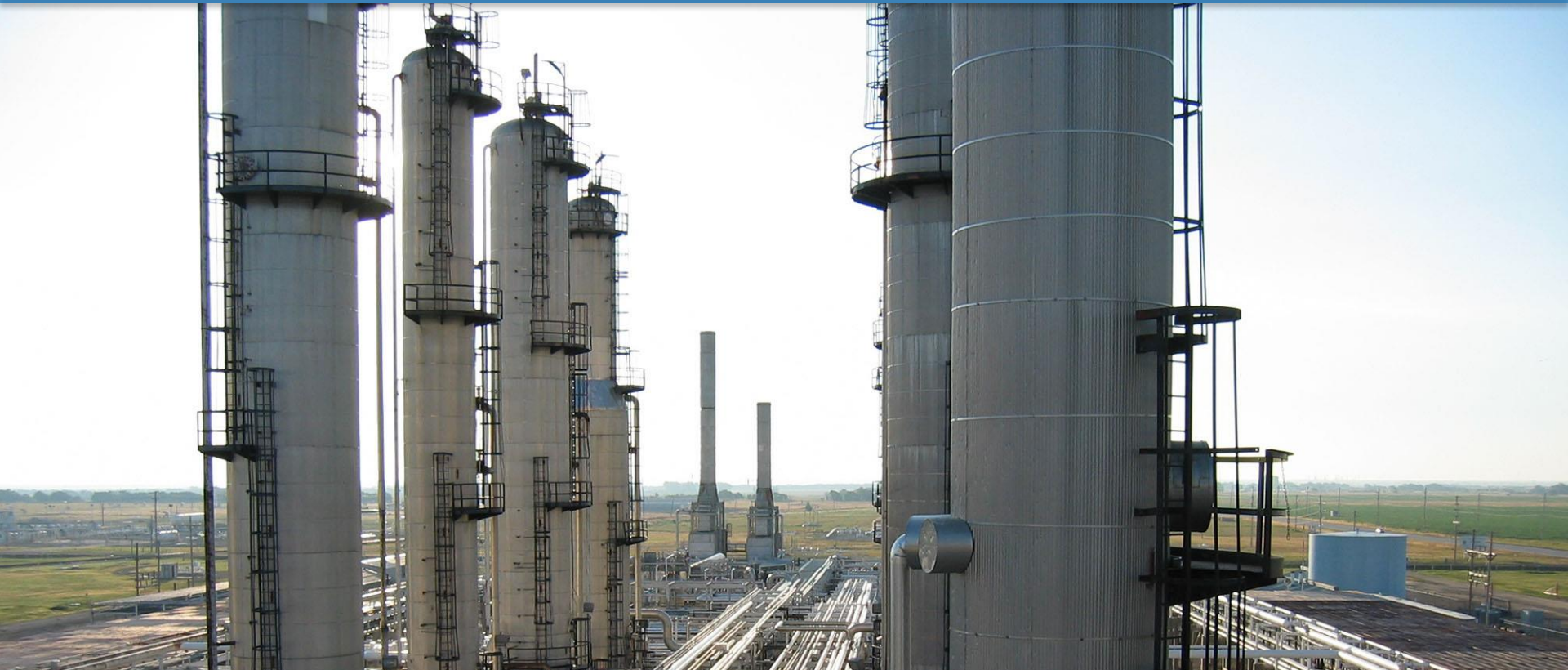

- Fortune 500 company traded on the NYSE as WMB

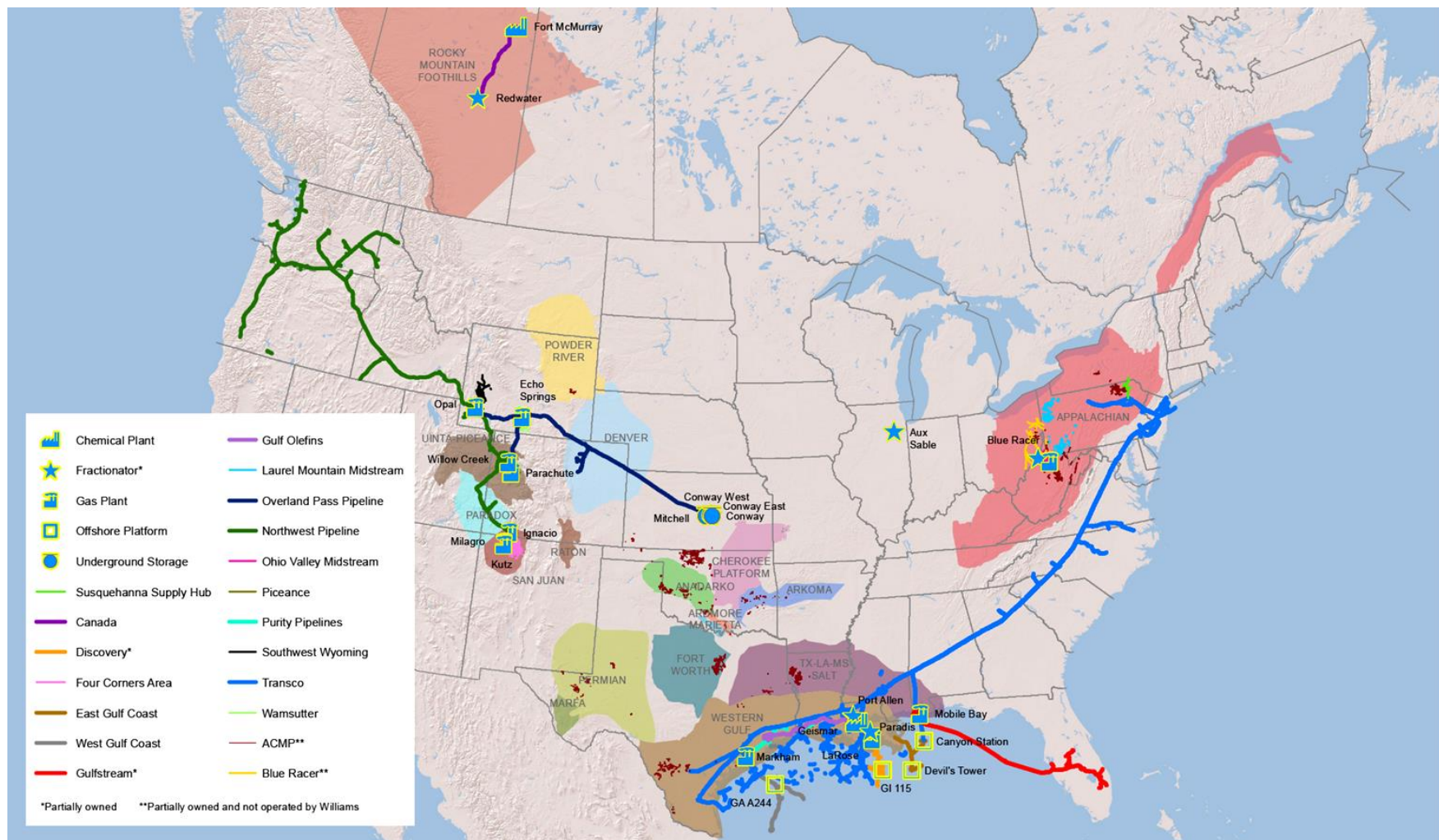
Williams Vision

Canadian Operations

- > Williams is the only processor of oil sands upgrader olefinic offgas in Canada with the capability of fully fractionating and marketing offgas liquids.
- > Through our operations in Fort McMurray and in Sturgeon County we are providing both significant environmental benefits and high-value upgrading services to oil sands upgraders.

- Long-term ethane sale to NOVA Chemicals up to 17,000 bbl/d
- In-service December 2013

CNRL Horizon Offgas Processing



- Long-term contract up to 15,000 bbl/d NGLs/olefins
- Will reduce annual upgrader CO₂ emissions
- 300 construction jobs created at Redwater site
- All Modules constructed in Edmonton area
- Liquids extraction plant now under construction
- Pipeline construction complete
- Q4 2015 in-service date

Williams Alberta PDH



Alberta PDH

- > First facility of its kind in Canada
- > Will produce 525 kilo tonnes of polymer grade propylene annually
- > Received regulatory approval to construct in January 2015
- > ATCO Power chosen to build cogeneration plant to supply electricity and steam

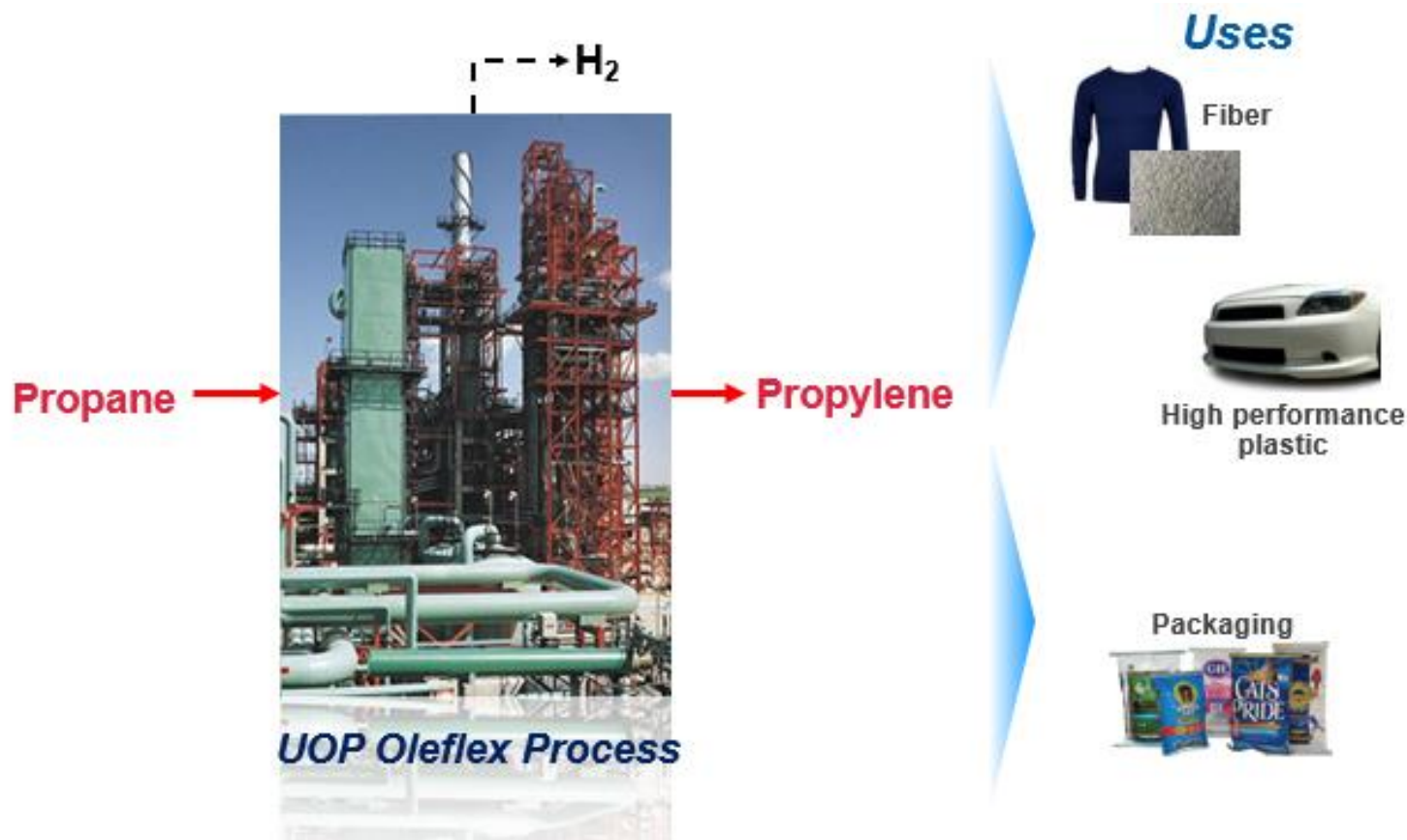
Williams Alberta PDH



Alberta PDH

- > 700 Construction jobs anticipated and 70 full time jobs
- > Propylene delivered to an on-site polypropylene derivatives plant or railed to the US Gulf Coast
- > Q4 2018 in-service
