

FAP Air Monitoring Network


Mission: Operate a regional network to monitor and report on credible and comprehensive ambient air quality information.


- Boundary: 4500 km²
- **Monitoring Sites:**
- 9 continuous stations
 - One-minute data
- 55 passive sites
 - Monthly averages



Real Time Air Quality Information

- Air Quality Health Index
 - Current and forecast
 - Updated hourly
 - AQHI graph for all 6 stations posted on-line weekly.
- Live data feed to website
 - Continuous, updated hourly
 - Search by station or by substance





Redwater Air Monitoring Station

- Focus on regional monitoring and monitoring air quality where people live.
- Began operatingOctober 2017
- Monitors sulphur dioxide, hydrogen sulphide, nitric oxide, nitrogen dio



oxide, nitrogen dioxide, oxides of nitrogen, ozone, fine particulate matter and weather conditions.

Provides data to calculate the Air Quality Health Index
